Outreach Program #1a: Genre Exploration Through Song

Objective: Transform a classic song into different musical genres.

<u>Activity</u>: Select a universally known song (e.g., "You Are My Sunshine"). Explore 2-3 distinct genres by analyzing and discussing their unique musical elements like rhythms and harmonies, as well as their cultural and historic elements. Students participate in rearranging the song into these genres, engaging in hands-on activities like singing along and clapping genre-specific rhythms as Nate leads from the piano. No musical experience is needed!

<u>Learning Outcomes:</u> Understanding of unique characteristics of different genres, how songs are arranged, accessing critical listening skills, and collaborative music-making.

Outreach Program #1b: Genre Exploration Through Song (Bigger Assembly)

Objective: Transform a classic song into different musical genres.

<u>Activity</u>: Select a universally known song (e.g., "You Are My Sunshine"). Ask students to give me 4 different genres or styles to play the song on piano. After I play the song in different genres, we explore the unique musical elements of the 4 genres,like rhythms and harmonies, as well as cultural and historical elements.

<u>Learning Outcomes:</u> Understanding of unique characteristics of different genres, how songs are arranged, accessing critical listening skills, and collaborative music-making.

Outreach Program #2: Creative Mashup Workshop

Objective: Develop skills in creating song mashups.

<u>Activity</u>: Students suggest two contrasting songs. The class will dissect these songs, identifying signature sections and finding overlapping elements. Through group experimentation and feedback, the class will craft a unique mashup. Students are then encouraged to create their own mashups. This workshop is best suited for music classes.

<u>Learning Outcomes</u>: Critical listening skills, understanding song structure, and creativity in music arrangement.

Outreach Program #3: Digital Music Arrangement with GarageBand

Objective: Learn song arrangement and recording using digital tools.

<u>Activity</u>: Choose a familiar or current hit song. Students will help Nate record each part of the song using GarageBand on the iPad, understanding song composition and recording processes. The class will experiment with adding unusual instruments or effects to create a unique arrangement.

<u>Learning Outcomes:</u> Basic digital recording skills, insight into song composition, and creative expression through digital music tools.
